## Remote Learning Guidance for Pupils

Video calls will take place between a member of staff and at least two pupils. These will be at a scheduled time during normal school hours.

A member of staff will be the host for the event. The session will be recorded by the member of staff and will be available to all pupils who have been invited to the event after it has finished. In line with UK GDPR legislation, pupils will not take photos or screenshots of any member of a meeting or meeting recording, unless they have that person's explicit consent in writing. Any breaches of this will be handled by the police.

Everybody who is participating or who may be in view of the camera should be dressed appropriately.

Please make sure that the camera has a blurred background. Pupils should be in an appropriate area in the house, such as a living room, dining room or hallway. They should not be in a bathroom. If pupils have to attend the meeting from the bedroom because their device is not portable, their video should have a blurred background.

All participants are expected to behave in line with the existing St Egwin's behaviour policy outlined in the school planner. We expect everyone to be respectful, kind to each other and to use appropriate language. Pupils may be asked to leave the session if their behaviour falls below expectations.
